Uniform

Now we are in the Summer term and the weather is warmer, we have made some minor adjustments to the uniform policy to include a summer uniform.

Girls may wear a navy blue dress or a short sleeved shirt (not blouse) and skirt. Provided that the shirt is short sleeved then a tie need not be worn and their top button may be undone.

Boys may wear grey shorts with a short sleeved shirt. Provided shorts are worn and the shirt is short sleeved a tie need not be worn and the top button may be undone.

If long trousers or long sleeves are worn then a tie must be worn too. We are not mixing and matching summer/winter uniform.

We really hope that this will mean children are more comfortable in warmer weather and feel that their viewpoint has had an impact on policy.



As the pollen count starts to rise we do appreciate that if your child is a hay fever sufferer they may need to take regular medication such as eye drops, nasal spray, piriton etc. to ease the symptoms. If taking medicine in school hours is absolutely necessary please ensure you have completed a self administration form to accompany the medicine you send in. All medications must be prescribed by a doctor and handed in at the school office. At the moment, Aviva are offering a donation of up to £30, Hastings Direct £19 if you buy your insurance via this link, and Confused.com will donate £1.15 just for you getting a quote.

There are many of the retailers that you shop with all of the time offering to support our school in return for your business. Other examples include; hotel bookings Travelodge, Booking.com, online groceries, Sainsbury's will donate 50p every time you do an online order, switching energy providers

If you sign up via the link that we email to you, Easy Fundraising will pay school a £1 donation when you raise your first donation.
