Every half term as part of our Safeguarding strategy for keeping our children safe, we will be running a safety afternoon. During these afternoons children will learn about the many ways in which they can stay safe. This will range from learning about dangers in the home, fire safety, and crossing the road, to e safety issues. We want our children to be able to confidently evaluate risks and know what to do in a variety of situations. Your explanations will differ slightly from ours and will consolidate what they've learnt. Each half term will build on the previous half term and each area taught will be age related. This half term we started with an assembly about safety around fireworks.
