Mark Garnier MP hails new changes as fair and feasible

On Wednesday the government announced plans to address the current imbalance in the school funding system. The announcement signals a transition into new reforms after Mark Garnier MP, alongside other MPs, successfully campaigned to get rid of the old funding formula. This was backed by local schools and parents through a petition which Mark Garnier presented in the House of Commons at the start of December last year. Many thanks to all our parents who signed the petition. New funding is proposed for 2017/18.


