- Sportsday will go ahead, however a Summer Fair would be unlikely due to ongoing restrictions.
- Virtual Stalls could be charged at £10 or £15. The PTFA would then market the event.
 The group agreed this would be worth exploring further. Lizzie will follow-up with Louise directly.
- Food stalls with a family picnic was discussed. We could an entry free to the picnic. Any food would likely need to be ordered in advance. If the weather is inclement, the attendees could simply take their food home with them. A survey could be run before the event to get an idea of numbers. Sarah to follow-up with the Sticky Fig caterers at Harvington Hall. The field can be accessed by a main gate behind after school club, to allow a caterer to be onsite.
- Raffle will be organised. Appropriate local business could be approached for prizes.
 Facebook post could be used to seek out businesses willing to donate. The raffle will started in the summer term.
- Break-the-rule day: £1 per rule, then 50p per rule thereafter, to a maximum of five rules: i.e. nail varnish, bring chocolate for snack etc etc.
- Quiz / Where's Wally: Sheets for book bags. Oli to look into options.
- Sponsored walk with medals for everyone who takes part. With a totaliser showing how far we have collectively walked, with competition between year groups.
