Hot Lunches

There still seems to be some confusion re ordering hot meals for children. The food is provided by Shire Services and they collect the money from us every week, collate the lists of children having hot meals and pass on the numbers to the kitchens. They need the numbers in advance, so that they can order the correct quantities of food. See below for examples of when to pay.

- If you would like your child to have hot lunches, please ensure that you send your order and payment into school on Monday mornings.
- Please put your payment in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name, the dates that you want your child to have a meal and the total amount due enclosed.
- If you are paying by cash, you must enclose the correct amount as change cannot be given. If you are paying by cheque, please make payable to Shropshire Council.
- Hot lunches can be paid for in advance via our online payment facility Payments4Schools.
- You can pay for as many weeks as you wish online.
- If you are paying online and do not want lunch every day, please send a brief email to office@chaddesleycorbett.worcs.sch.uk with your child's name, class and the dates that you want food for e.g. Tues 5/11, Wed 6/11, Wed 13/11.

Payment4School (Payments online)

- A reminder that trips, hot lunches, milk, music lessons and uniform can be paid for online. It is an easy way to make payments and means no more having to find the right change, find an envelope or wonder who to make a cheque payable to – give it a go!

After School Sports Clubs

- Where possible, children will be changing in the hall and leaving their belongings there during the activity.
- Football boots must not be worn in school.
- If you are helping your child, please wait until your child is outside before putting on their boots and ensure that they are removed before they come back in.

Medicines Reminder

If your child needs to have medicine during the school day, please ensure that the medicine is given to the school office, clearly labelled with your child's name, and that you have completed a "Self Administration" form for your child.

Please note that this will only apply to children in Years 3 to 6. Children in Reception to Year 2 needing medicine during the day will require you to come in to school to administer.

Please note that although we are not allowed to administer medicine to your child, if your child remembers to come to the office and we have the medication and completed form we will supervise them taking the medicine. Please on **no account** put medication such as sachets of Calpol etc in your child's lunch box or book bag.
