Are you eligible for Free School Meals?

Did you know that children registered on free school meals means that School can receive financial support for extracurricular activities through the Pupil Premium Initiative? As well as the benefits of your child eating a hot meal, especially during the cold winter months, Pupil Premium can open the door to additional support in school. If you think you may be eligible for free school meals please contact the school office for a form to register.

Please note – your child does not have to have the free school meal they can still bring a packed lunch if preferred but they will still need to be registered for School to benefit.

Hot Lunches and Christmas Lunch

A reminder that if your child has not ordered a Christmas lunch for Wednesday 18th December, they will need to bring a packed lunch with them on that day. The deadline for ordering Christmas lunch has now passed and there will be no alternative hot lunch on that day.

If you would like your child to have hot lunches this is what you need to do:-

- Ensure you send your order and payment into school on Monday mornings.
- Put your payment in an envelope clearly marked with your child's name, the dates that you want your child to have a meal and the total amount enclosed.
- If you are paying by cash, you must enclose the correct amount as change cannot be given. If you are paying by cheque, please make payable to Shropshire Council.
- Hot lunches can be paid for in advance via our online payment facility Payments4Schools.
- You can pay for as many weeks as you wish online.
- If you are paying online and do not want lunch every day, please send a brief email to office@chaddesleycorbett.worcs.sch.uk with your child's name, class and the dates that you want food for e.g. Tues 5/11, Wed 6/11, Wed 13/11.
