Beginning and end of the School Day

Children are to arrive at school between 8.30am and 8.45am, and with the exception of the Reception pupils, who go into school via the Reception playground, should make their way to the upper playground ready to line up for when the bell is rung at 8.45am.

If your child arrives between 8.45am and 9.05am they are to make their way to their classroom via their cloakroom. After 9.05am they need to come into school via the main office.

Children arriving between 9.05am and 9.15am will be marked as late. After this time they will be marked as "late after the register is closed" and this is recorded as an unauthorised absence for that session.

Once the children are handed over to you, or the person collecting them, at the end of the day, they are in **your** care, and their safety is **your** responsibility. We have noticed an increase in the number of children running on ahead and into the car park. We are concerned about their safety and ask that they stay close to the person collecting them.

If you did not place a hot lunch order for your child during the last week of term for the beginning of next term please remember to send a packed lunch to school with your child for the first week back. You will then be able to order hot lunches again as follows:-
