

WYAC has been going for over 10 years, and meets monthly at various locations across the county. A branch of the national Young Archaeologists' Club, we are supported by Worcestershire County Council & Worcester City Historic Environment Record, and the volunteer leaders have a range of skills and experiences to help members.

We have a wide range of activities, and always try to provide young people with opportunities they may not get else, allowing them to have a go at archaeological activities and learn new skills. Activities this year will include surveying a disused graveyard, finding out about moats and what we can tell from rubbish, recording buildings archaeologically, discovering Civil War Worcester, investigating the archaeology of woodland, exploring a canal and hopefully an excavation.
