



SEN Drop-in

Many apologies but there will be no SEN Drop-in available this Friday or next Friday 6th March. You are however more than welcome to make an appointment for another time.

In preparation for World Book Day, which we are celebrating on Thursday 5th March, we have organised for two authors, a Mother (Jo Allmond) and daughter (Jess Hiles) team to visit the school. The story they have written together is called Jess the Goth Fairy. They will be visiting on Wednesday 4th March 2015.



Jess the Goth Fairy has learning and physical disabilities, just like the real Jess. Wings that don't work very well, so flying is scary and landing is a nightmare! She looks different, doesn't do pink or wear those awful things called dresses 'YEUKK!' Jess also copes with other disabilities that make having a normal life as a fairy very challenging.

Jess Hiles, the inspiration for the book lives independently with support in Worcestershire despite having learning and physical disabilities. Both authors will read and use sign language to tell the story to each class and the children will have an opportunity to ask questions.

Books will be available to buy from the school office at £7.99 each and it would be very nice for our families to support Jess in this way.

As well as meeting with the authors and hearing their story on Wednesday, the children will spend time during Thursday listening to other stories and generally celebrating books and reading.

To make Thursday lots of fun it would be fantastic if children could come to school dressed up as a character from their favourite book.



Reminder that we'll be holding our rags2riches event on Thurs 23rd April. It's not too soon to start collecting items-eg second hand clothing, soft good quality toys, bedding, towels and accessories. Items will be collected from school and we'll get paid 65p per kilo or £650 per tonne which will help us to raise much needed funds towards the ICT project.
