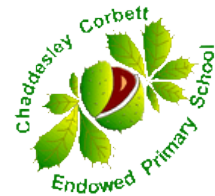

The children have really enjoyed learning about lots of different aspects of science and we hope you have enjoyed working along side the children. Here is an example of some the science activities:-

Yrs 4, 5 & 6 tested the strength of materials and shapes by making spaghetti towers strong enough to hold chocolate eggs. They enjoyed lots of healthy competition and learned a lot about the science of engineering too!



Pupils investigated how to make the best bubbles, which, for year 6 meant the bubbles lasted the longest. They even played 'keeps-uppies' on their knees with the bubbles.
