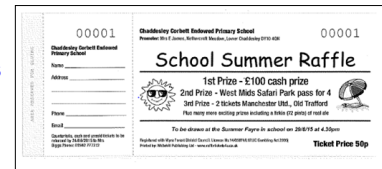




Summer Fayre - Monday 29th June

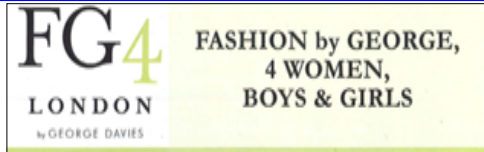


It was so lovely to see so many parents at the Year 1 Inspire English Workshop on Thursday.
