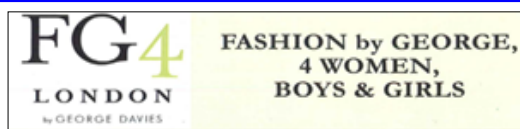
Hands up for fair pupil funding

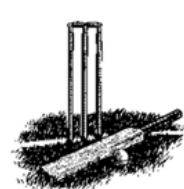
