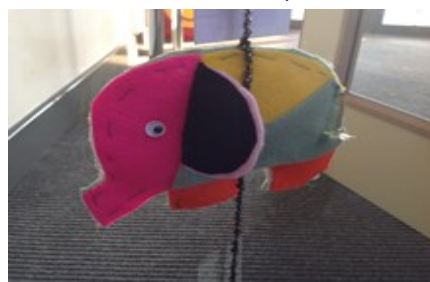

But it is important to remember that you, or your children, might come across inappropriate content during a search, even if searching the most seemingly harmless of topics.

Google SafeSearch is a feature which helps you keep adult content out of search results.
