YouTube SafetyMode enables you to choose whether to limit content on YouTube that might be unsuitable for your children, even though it's not against YouTube community Guidelines.

When you opt in to YouTube SafetyMode, videos with mature content or that have been age restricted will not show up in video search, related videos, playlists, shows and movies. It is extremely simple to set up.
