Our next Parent Forum Meeting will take place on Friday 11th March at 9.40am, just after our Achievement Assembly. All parents are welcome to attend.

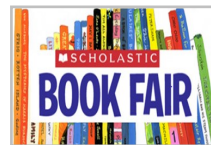
