After School Chess Club

Would you like to learn how to play chess? Or do you play chess already and wish to play against others.

Now is your chance! Chess requires you to think hard, analyse, plan and execute. Problem solving and learning are part of the game. The 'Chess in Schools' programme has success built into the lessons; children learn they can take on something challenging and be successful. Chess also has smart "brand association," children who play chess believe they are smart. This is no ordinary chess club!

Children will be taught chess through the cross-curricular concepts of maths, science, reading, writing, history and S.T.E.M. Each lesson underpins key learning taught in 'traditional' lessons. So, if you are completely new to the game or would like to develop your understanding and mastery then this is the club for you!

Chess club will be available to pupils in KS2 and will take place on Wednesdays after school from 3.20pm - 4.30pm, £3.75 per week payable in advance.
