Behaviour Policy

Here at Chaddesley Corbett we pride ourselves on the excellent behaviour of our pupils. The number of golds awarded is testimony that the vast majority of children behave extremely well and follow our school rules conscientiously.

However, we all make mistakes sometimes and for most of these the zone board works very well both as a deterrent and a consequence.

Very occasionally a pupil may behave in a way that requires more serious consequences. Because we are always trying to be better, we are reviewing our behaviour policy so that the sanctions for these instances are laid out very clearly. This will be to benefit the children, parents and staff. Children will understand the consequences more clearly. Parents will know that sanctions will be consistent and it will support staff who can apply a strict criteria and follow it more easily.

We are currently trialling our ideas and will inform parents/carers as soon as we have a final version.

Wraparound Care

A reminder that unless it is an emergency, bookings, **and payments**, should be made in advance. This is to enable us to plan for how much food to prepare and to ensure we have the correct ratio of staff to children.

Payments for emergencies should be paid within 24 hours of using wraparound care.
