The children in year 3 had a wonderful day at Winterfold House School on Friday for the annual event 'Sing it'. They learned five songs in a day, some with actions,



some with vocal accompaniment and harmony and others performed in a round. They did amazingly well and parents and carers who attended the performance commented on how impressed they were. Mrs Richardson, one of our Governors, who ran the event made learning songs great fun and one of the children who attended last year said 'it was even better than last time.' We would like to thank Winterfold House School for organising such a superb experience for our children.

Hands on Science Day

Year 3 and 4 had the opportunity to make elastic band racers. Children were put into small teams of 2 or 3 and were challenged to create a racer that would go the furthest just using the energy stored within an elastic band (no pushing allowed!).



Although there were some issues with how to steer the racers, all children were able to create a racer that was able to travel under elastic band power alone. The teams then had to go through a qualifying round (reaching a minimum of 5 metres) to reach the final. The winners achieved a very impressive 10m. Well done to all of the children who worked so well together in making their racers.



Year five and six also learned about potential energy by creating cars powered by rubber bands! It was great fun and particularly great to see all children taking part and working well in their teams.

Members of Year 2 wowed us by using some impressive scientific vocabulary. They used a range of skills such as predicting, observing reasoning and explaining. The children particularly enjoyed observing the chemical reaction that took place between lemon juice and bicarbonate of soda, resulting in a mini explosion!

Children from Reception and Key Stage 1 enjoyed their workshop which included making Rockets from straws. They loved showing Mrs Beard how high the rockets could go! They wrote about their rockets later and drew pictures too. Lauren (our Scientist) from Hands on Science was very impressed with the scientific knowledge of the older children in the group - who gave some excellent explanations re forces and energy.
