Everyone had a great time during their outdoor classroom day. Here's what some of the children got up to:-

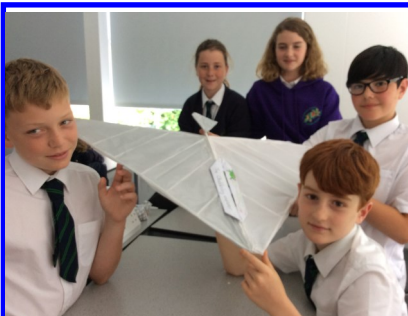
