## Shire Services Hot Lunches

Please be aware that after half term the process for ordering hot lunches is being tightened up by Shire Services. Please see details below:-

**Hot lunches must be ordered and paid for a week in advance.**

Orders and payments are to be sent into school before Thursday at least one week in advance of when hot lunches are required. **Orders and payments received after this time will not be accepted and you will need to provide a packed lunch for your child that week.**

Therefore if you wish to order hot lunches for your child for the week after half term (week commencing 31st October) your order and payment will need to be sent into school before Thursday 20th October.

Payments can be made online, via [payments4schools](http://payments4schools), or sent in a clearly marked envelope with your child's name, year group, dates when lunch is required & the amount enclosed if sending cash or cheque. If your child is in receipt of free school meals, a hot lunch will automatically be ordered unless you tell us otherwise.
