Special thanks go to the children in Year 6 who read beautifully, and also to Sylvia Beardshaw, member of the local History Society, who talked to us about the names of the people on the World War I plaque that has been transferred to our new school from the old school. It is now proudly hung in our school hall. Everyone found it really interesting to hear about

local people who fought and lost their lives in the war and held them in their thoughts during our 2 minutes silence. Each class made poppies or wreaths to display during the service which were lovely. These were transferred to St Cassian's Church afterwards to be used during their service on Sunday.



Last Friday twenty eight Year 5 & 6 children went to St Anne's Primary school in Bewdley to take part in the annual Wyre Forest Schools

Cross Country Running Festival. Each race involved about 150 children and was just over a mile long.
