Anti-Bullying Week

During anti-bullying week we talked about what bullying is and the different types of bullying. We talked about STOP (Several Times On Purpose) and discussed how to be a good friend and who can help you if you think you are being bullied.

KS2 had a visit from the Takeaway Theatre Company with their production of 'Hope'. It was a "Contemporary and Powerful" production that combined music and drama. It told the story of three young people who were all affected by bullying in different ways.



In Year 2 we established a definition of bullying. We looked at the STOP rule (Several Times on Purpose) and then took this into types of behaviour - kind, rude, mean and bullying. The children worked together to give examples of each type of behaviour. We also discussed what we would do in different situations (this is what the photo is linked to) - would we say something, tell an adult, walk away or join in. Year 2 showed a great level of majority in these discussions and often discussed a sequence they would take so if one way didn't work this is what they would do next. We finished the week by creating a class poem expressing all the kind acts we would do for the 'Power of Good'.
