Well done to all those involved.



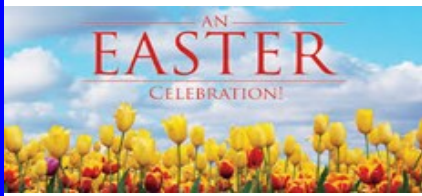
Thank you for all the Sainsbury's
