On Thursday morning Year 4 enjoyed some time out of the classroom to experience Tesco's Farm To Fork trail. They visited Tesco Extra in Kidderminster where they met Amanda and Andrea who showed them round the store and organised lots of interesting activities for the children to learn from. The first activity saw the children create their own dough shapes which were then transported down to the bakery ready to be collected at the end of the trip. The children took a tour of the bakery and learned the ingredients needed to make the perfect bread and just how many loaves and buns were made each day. After this they went on a hunt around the produce section to find as many fruits and vegetables as possible and where they all came from. They asked lots of good questions such as "Why do we need to get some fruits from places so far away?" The trail then continued to the fish counter where they learnt about the different kinds of fish and how they have adapted to protect themselves from predators and

were treated to a live filleting of a mackerel! The trip ended with the children being encouraged to try different foods, including pomegranate, pineapple, raspberries and a wide selection of different cheeses.
