They got to sample a range of fruit and vegetables, visit the bakery and bake their own bread. We visited the fish counter and discovered the variety of fish that we can eat, and also sampled different cheeses from the cheese counter. This really supported and inspired us in our learning for the rest of the week, where we have learnt about the different food groups and the quantities we need to eat of each of them to have a healthy diet. We used this knowledge to prepare and cook a simple meal that had a range of food groups within it. We all had a lovely week and I know the children learnt lots of valuable information.
