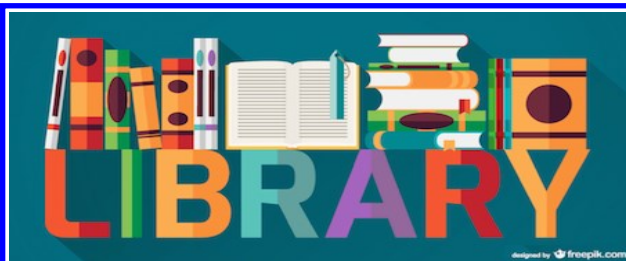
Please remember to book wraparound care for the Autumn Term before Friday 21st July 2017.
