Welcome back to a new academic year at School. We hope you had a wonderful summer holiday and are refreshed and ready for the new term. Over the summer, National Attainment Data was released and we are delighted to announce that we are above national average in Early Years, Foundation Stage (EYFS), Phonics and Key Stage 2 in reading, writing and maths combined. We are particularly pleased that our progress levels have gone up by nearly 8 points overall, which is a fantastic achievement. A summary of our data will be on the website today.
