- ParentPay is quick and easy to use.




## Fun Phonics'

This course will introduce parents/carers to phonics in the Early Years (nursery, pre-school, reception, key stage 1). Focusing on a different phonics aspect each week and every session parents will come away with homemade phonics resources to help their child.

This course is to explain what phonics means, what the jargon means that they will hear at school and help them understand current school teaching methods to help their child at home.

## Crafty Maths

For parents of Pre-school children, Reception Children and Key stage 1 children to teach them about maths and to show them how to make maths resources to use at home to support their young child with maths.
