Parking in the morning when dropping off children

To ensure that traffic can flow on and off site as efficiently as possible in a morning, **cars should pull up parallel to the kerb in the drop off zone** so that children can exit the car onto the footpath to walk to the playground. **Please do not park in the bays!**
