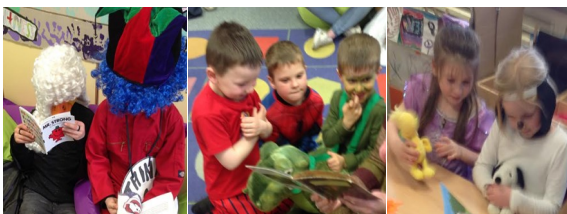
Due to the Teacher Education Day, certificates will be awarded in our next Achievement Assembly on Friday 22nd March 2019
