Please ensure you've completed the order form and sent it into school and made your payment online via your ParentPay account. We'll be sending off the order to the suppliers on Tuesday morning.

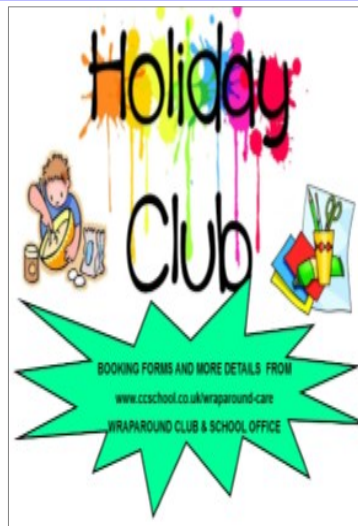
Home School Link Worker
