The children participated in a variety of citizenship tasks and workshops, in particular learning about "stranger danger". Despite a very wet morning, the children were attentive and listened well at all times, all being fabulous ambassadors for the school.



On Tuesday volunteers from the Canal and Riverside Trust came into school to advise children in Years 3 - 6 of how to keep safe around water.
