### Speech, Language & Communication Skills Newsletter Tips

Speech, language and communication skills are important for all children, not just those with identified needs. This fun activity will heighten your awareness of speaking and listening and in turn develop language skills that are so important to literacy and learning.

#### Tip 2: Listening skills.

For children to develop listening skills they need to practice them. In busy family lives there is often little quiet time. Try and reduce distracting noise. If no one is watching the TV, turn it off. There's enough volume in most homes without music on as well. Do a little every day to develop listening skills. One simple idea to get you started is: when you lose your mobile phone in the house, call it from the landline and ask the kids to find it.

### Guidance for being absent from school



Please think carefully about keeping your child at home. If they feel unwell, often it is some small anxiety that once they are at school is dealt with easily.

**If your child has a cold then please still send them in. Unless they have a contagious illness or sickness and diarrhoea please send them into school.**

We would never allow a genuinely ill child to stay in school if we felt they really needed bed rest or would be at risk to other children; so can assure you we'd ring you immediately.

If medication is required in school, eg. calpol, nurofen, antibiotics etc, as per our "Supporting Pupils with Medical Conditions" policy, this can only be administered to a child if we have a completed medication consent form clearly stating the dose and time for it to be administered. Forms can be downloaded from our website [www.ccschool.co.uk](http://www.ccschool.co.uk), Parents & Carers tab, Guidance for Illnesses tab and then click on the relevant tab depending on whether the medication is prescribed or non prescribed. Forms are also available at Breakfast Club, if you are dropping your child off before school and from the school office. Please feel free to ask for a form if one is not offered.

Persistent absence brings with it the risk of a fixed penalty notice from the Local Authority. There is no set number of days allowed for absence because apart from exceptional circumstances, a parent must legally send their child to school for all sessions while they are of compulsory school age.

### Instrument Tuition Fees

A reminder that instrument tuition fees are now paid via your ParentPay account.

This gives you flexibility of making payments, weekly, monthly or all in one go, if preferred.

However, please note that tuition fees must be paid in full by Friday 14th February 2020 or it may result in your child's instrument lessons being cancelled.

If your move house, change your mobile phone or email address please don't forget to let the school office know.

Also under the new GDPR guidance, please be aware that you have the right to withdraw your consent for the sharing of personal information at any time.
