Speech, Language & Communication Skills Newsletter Tips

Speech, language and communication skills are important for all children, not just those with identified needs. This fun activity will heighten your awareness of speaking and listening and in turn develop language skills that are so important to literacy and learning.

Tip 4: Outdoor listening game. A listening game that works best outdoors. Stand still and ask everyone to close their eyes. Listen to the sounds that you hear. One player names a sound that they can hear.

Everyone points to the sound. Then on the count of 3 everyone opens their eyes. Are you all pointing in the same direction?
