Winter Uniform - All Pupils

- Grey long trousers / navy blue pinafore dress or navy blue skirt
- Navy blue embroidered V-neck sweatshirt or navy blue cardigan embroidered with the school logo
- Long or short sleeve white shirt buttoned at the neck
- School tie
- Grey / white socks or grey / navy blue tights
- Black / navy shoes (not trainers or boots)

Please ensure that all items of school uniform, P.E. Kit, shoes, wellies, coats, equipment, lunch boxes, drinks bottles are marked clearly with your child's name. Use labels or permanent marker pen as quite often names are written on items in pen which fade or disappear when they're washed.
