Speech, Language & Communication Skills Newsletter Tips

Speech, language and communication skills are important for all children, not just those with identified needs. This fun activity will heighten your awareness of speaking & listening and in turn develop language skills that are so important to literacy & learning.

10. Advice Talking is important. It is closely linked to reading, writing and learning. Did you know that research shows that spoken language abilities at 5 years of age predict their reading at 15? By playing simple speaking and listening games you may not think you are developing reading and writing, but you are. Get talking!

Authorised Collection

If you would like someone else to regularly collect your child from school, and they are not on your child's authorised collection list, please let the school office know and they will add them to the list for you.

This means that as long as the person collecting your child is on your child's authorised collection list then you won't need to advise the teacher or the school office.
