Speech, Language & Communication Skills

Newsletter Tips

Speech, language and communication skills are important for all children, not just those with identified needs. This fun activity will heighten your awareness of speaking & listening and in turn develop language skills that are so important to literacy & learning.

12. Chinese Whisper. If you've got lots of friends or family over play 'Chinese Whisper.' One player thinks of a sentence. He /she whispers it to another person once. This second person then whispers the message to the next person and so on down the line. The last person says the sentence out loud. Does it match what the first speaker said? Probably not! Emphasise to children that you need to listen to get the best result.
