Speech, language and communication skills are important for all children, not just those with identified needs. This fun activity will heighten your awareness of speaking & listening and in turn develop language skills that are so important to literacy & learning.

Choose a topic that your child is interested in and ask them select two items from that topic. Can they say what is same and different about two things? For instance: from Toy Story they could compare Buzz Light-Year and Woody or from Harry Potter it could be Sirius and Voldemort.

From the 24th February the booking procedure for Wraparound Care is changing.

Booking Procedure

For Breakfast Buddies Breakfast club and Mix 'til Six After School Club bookings, you'll need to log into your ParentPay account and click on the dates and sessions you require and make payment. Booking online will be available from **Saturday 15th February 2020**. You will have the option to book as many days or weeks as you wish to pay for.

NB. Holiday Club - Unfortunately, due to the number of sessions available for Holiday Club, ParentPay have advised us that it is not possible to book online via your ParentPay account for these sessions. For Holiday Club you will still need to complete a booking form, as you do at the moment, and hand it in to the School Office or to one of the Wraparound Care Team. Payment is still made via your ParentPay account.

If you normally pay for wraparound care or holiday club using childcare vouchers could we please ask you to make separate payments for each child for each item ie. Breakfast Club, After School Club or Holiday club.
