I know you've seen in the news that schools may reopen on 1st June to Reception and Year 1 pupils if the government thinks it's safe by then.

I have begun the process of planning of how we would accomplish a phased reopening, while also continuing to safeguard our children and staff, which, at this time, is our number one priority. I will share this with you as soon as possible so you know what the school's reopening will look like in practice. I am following the government guidance, liaising with other local heads and working closely with my site team and staff.

It's a very unsettling time for us all, but be rest assured that we will be doing everything we can to make sure we're ready to receive these year groups if it is safe for our school to reopen in the coming weeks.

However, in order to gauge numbers, if your child is in Nursery, Reception, Year 1 or Year 6, I will be sending out a letter asking you to indicate if you will not be requiring a place regardless of provision due to family vulnerability or any other reason. We're not going to be pressuring anyone to send their children to school, since you know your children and personal situation best.


We will keep you updated with all our preparations for making sure the school is as safe as possible, so that you can make an informed decision.
