Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to be able to offer all of our children the opportunity of some sessions in school. We have worked really hard to make this possible due to space constraints and limited staff because of class sizes being no larger than 15. However, we have been creative and come to a solution that is **fair to all year groups** and will give the children some time with their peers to recalibrate ready for a return to school in September - we dearly hope!

We are inviting your child to come to school for a morning, **every week**, from the 22nd June. Please see below for your year group day. We aim to offer a forest school session with the focus on relationships and working/playing with others. If the weather does not allow us to use the outdoors, we will use the D/T room and the hall but the focus will remain the same. We would like you to commit to the four sessions if possible so that your child can gain the full benefit.

Your Child will need forest school clothes (even if the weather is bad), a drink, a snack, a sun hat/rain coat and sun cream. They should arrive at school at 9am where they will be directed by myself to the designated forest school site for their pupil group. They will be encouraged to wash their hands regularly and all resources will be washed down after use. The children will be organised into pupil groups of no more than 15, which will limit mixing, however, please be aware that it **will not** be possible to social distance within these groups. We ask that you collect your child at 12noon from the front of the building.


Please be assured that all risk assessments and considerations for safety have been carefully considered and designated areas will be given for toileting and handwashing. Research shows that use of the outside limits the spread of the virus and the benefits of mental wellbeing are of prime importance.

Key worker children who have been lucky enough to be in school **will remain** with the key worker group. This is because they have a designated bubble of children they have been working with already and to integrate with the class sessions would compromise the integrity of the bubbles.

Please would you let the school know as soon as possible, via email, if you would like to take up this offer, stating your child's name and year group, so we can organise children into friendship groups.
