Following the 90kg Rice Challenge back in February we still have 1kg bags of rice for sale. 90kg of rice is the amount of rice a farmer in Malawi has to sell to enable him to send a child to secondary school for a year.



If you would like to buy a bag of rice (brown or white) they are available to purchase from the school office. Bags of rice are £3.20 each. Please ensure you bring the correct payment as change is not available.

The Kilombero rice from Malawi is a fair food, ethicalconsumer.org best buy and is produced by traditional cultivation methods which protect the environment.

The money raised will help provide a better life for those in some of the most poorest communities in Malawi.
