display them in the hall.

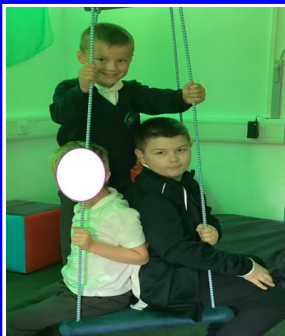
During this Jubilee year, we have learnt a lot about the life and

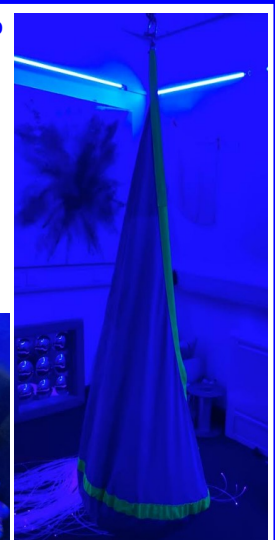
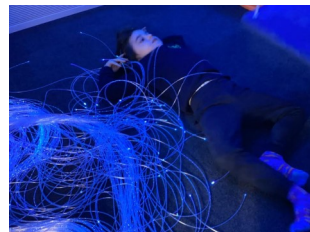
We would like to congratulate Thomas

studio including fibre optic lights, colour controlled light bars and a
colour control cube from THF based in Stourport-On-Severn. This
space is invaluable in providing opportunities for self-regulation, a
moment of calmness, responding to and developing visual, auditory
and tactile processing as well as a develop-
ing sense of body awareness
(proprioceptive), movement and
balance (vestibular). If you would
