## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

## Guidance for being absent from school

Please think carefully about keeping your child at home. If your child is unwell, often it is some small anxiety that  
once they are at school is dealt with easily.

**If your child has a cold then please still send them in.**

We would never allow a genuinely ill child to stay in school if we felt they really needed bed rest or would be at risk to other  
children; so can assure you we'd ring you immediately.

If medication is required in school, eg. calpol, nurofen, antibiotics etc, as per our "Supporting Pupils with Medical Conditions"  
policy, this can only be administered to a child if we have a completed medication consent form clearly stating the dose and time  
for it to be administered. Forms can be downloaded from our website [www.ccschool.co.uk](http://www.ccschool.co.uk), Parents & Carers, Guidance for  
Illnesses and then click on the relevant button depending on whether the medication is prescribed or non prescribed. Forms  
are also available at Breakfast Club, Nursery & Pre-School. Please feel free to ask for a form if one is not offered.

**In the event that your child has a contagious illness or sickness & diarrhoea then they should stay  
away from school for the length of time as stated on our "Guidance for Illnesses" page which is found on  
our website under the Parents & Carers tab, Guidance For Illnesses.**

Persistent absence brings with it the risk of a fixed penalty notice from the Local Authority. There is no set number of  
days allowed for absence because apart from exceptional circumstances, a parent/carer must legally send  
their child to school for all sessions while they are of compulsory school age.
