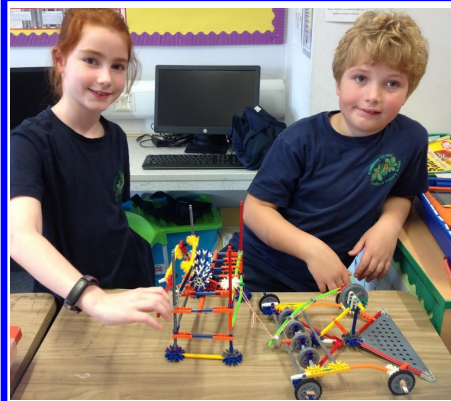

Boundless Outdoors Malvern

On 14th September, Year 6 pupils travelled to Boundless Outdoors in Malvern for their first residential visit. There was a mixture of emotions:

excitement about the many activities and spending so much time with their friends but some were a little anxious about being away from home for 2 nights. As soon as we arrived, we were greeted by the brilliant team who reassured us and built up our excitement about what was to come. The children had to make their own beds (which was quite a challenge for some) and ensure that they were dressed appropriately for each activity. They took part in rope courses, zip wire, problem solving games and even a long walk to the Beacon at Malvern Hills. The staff were so impressed by the children's resilience and teamwork and how well they encouraged other children who were feeling a little anxious. We were also relieved that bed times were peaceful! It has been brilliant to see the children grow in confidence and maturity over such a short period of time. Well done, Year 6!



On Thursday year 4 took part in The Primary Stem Challenge which was run by Stem Workshop. They had to design and build an automated warehouse using K'nex and were judged on their modelling work, their team-

work, communication and problem solving. All the children worked very hard and impressed us with their creative design skills but the final winners were Bethan Cooney and Thomas Whiteman who will go onto the Worcestershire Stem challenge final in June.



Total Communication Environment in the ARC

A Total Communication Environment is promoted at all times within the ARC and when transitioning around the wider

school. Over the coming months we will be expanding our visual communication approaches and strategies into the school to ensure Chaddesley Corbett Endowed Primary School becomes a Total Communication School and is accessible for all when meeting individual communication needs at all levels. Your children will have already seen the use of symbols at times and are always keen to ask questions about why we use them and what they mean. Other communication approaches that you may see include:-

- * Photographs & Symbols
- * Now: Next Schedules
- * Intensive Interaction
- * Talking Tiles
- * Token Object Based Icons (TOBIs)
- * Objects of Reference (OOR)
- * Sign Along
- * Picture Exchange Communication (PECs)

We accept that all behaviour is communication including facial expression, body language, sound and movement. At times, less desirable behaviours may be presented, it is essential that we are tuned into each individual child as communication partners to ensure that the intention of any communicative act is not missed.
