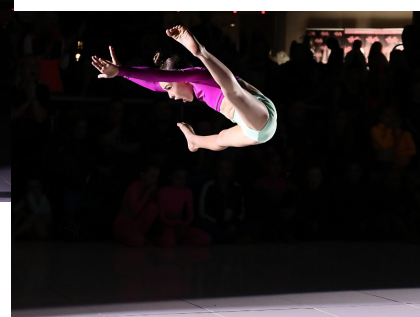


Early Years Foundation Stage had a great

If using the website at home, please visit play.ttrockstars.com/reset to load the latest version in on the device's browser. Otherwise update the Times Tables Rock Stars app from your app store.



FAME (First Access Music Education) lessons

This year we are introducing Year 2 & Year 3 to First Access Music Education (FAME) which is taught by a Severn Arts specialist instrumental teacher alongside the class teacher. Year 2 are being taught the recorder and Year 3 are being taught the ukulele

There are so many benefits for everyone taking part - improved pupil confidence, concentration, self-discipline and teamwork. Regardless of ability, all pupils can take part and learn about performing and composing, listening and appraising, posture and technique. Children are also taught the concepts of pitch (high and low sounds), dynamics (loud and quiet), basic structure, appropriate notation and vocabulary, and will develop an awareness of mood in the music.
