Autumn term update from the Governors

Governors have been busy behind the scenes as usual, with three full governing board and committee meetings so far this half term. At FGB we reviewed our strategic plan and our ambition for the school's continued improvement; the Resources committee reviewed the finances of the school to ensure all money is being effectively spent; and the Teaching & Learning committee analysed pupil attainment data and looked at the plans for this year to improve standards even further. We also welcomed our new parent governor, Oli Stokes.

Governors have also been present at school events whenever possible, meeting children, staff and parents/carers: the official opening of the ARC, Sports days, and parents' evenings. I always try to attend the achievement assemblies on Monday afternoon, and am happy to chat with any parents/carers afterwards, I'm pleased to say that a few of you have already taken up this offer. I was at the Parent Forum meeting this month, the first one with the nominated parent/carers representatives from each class. It was a really good experience to be there and hear at first hand some of the issues that parents had brought up. We're very grateful to the parents/carers who have put themselves forward for this, and I hope that this group will help to improve our communication systems and show that we are listening to and value the views of parents. One of the things discussed in that meeting was school uniform. Governors have since agreed to review the current policy on uniform in our school, and our first step is to survey all parents/carers to find out their views, so please look out for that questionnaire coming soon.

On behalf of the governors, thank you for continued support for the school.
