Support with Maths

Whenever possible, please can you give
your child the opportunity to buy things in a
shop using real money. This will help them
become familiar with coins. It also supports
their addition and subtraction as they can
start to see how much change they will get,
and with which coins. We know that many
places now use card payments, but we
have noticed that children are far less fa-
miliar with the coins that we use and are
struggling when we cover money in our
maths lessons.
