Parents/Carers of pupils in KS2, don't forget to make your payment via your ParentPay account against payment item 'Christmas Dinner'. If you have already paid for a hot dinner for your child for this day, a credit of £2.30 will remain on your account for a future date.

Please do not return the completed slip before making payment.

Parents/Carers of pupils in KS1, you only need to return the slip if your child requires an alternative to the Christmas Dinner ie if your child requires the vegetarian option, a sandwich provided by Shire Services, or to let us know that you will be providing a packed lunch from home.



National Sleep Helpline

At any given time up to 40% of adults and 50% of children (this rises to 80% with a SEND diagnosis) have difficulties with their sleep. Yet in a recent survey, almost 60% of adults felt there was a lack of support for sleep issues. Sleep problems can leave people feeling isolated and lonely.

The free helpline is run by trained sleep advisors, many of whom are specialists in working with SEND. They can talk to young people directly, or parents (they can also talk to adults, including older people, about their sleep issues).

The helpline is open 5 times a week, Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday evenings 7-9pm, and Wednesday mornings 9-11am. The number is 03303 530 541.
