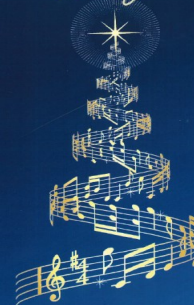

Pre-School Christmas Party

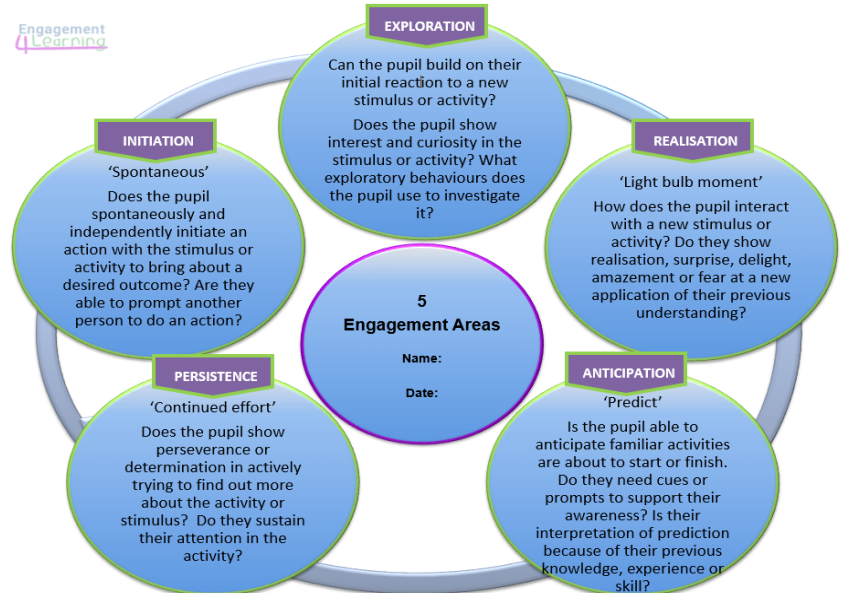
