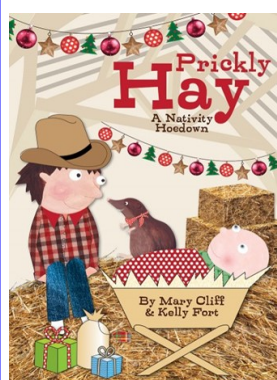
As we approach the end of 2022, looking after our physical and mental health remains incredibly important.
